Transracial Adoption and Racial Justice

Children of color are overrepresented in child welfare and foster care adoptions. The reasons for the disproportionality are many, including the systemic bias and unconscious racism among people who make reports about suspected child abuse, caseworkers and the general public. It is critical that caregivers understand this history in order to avoid perpetuating racism and to instead embrace an anti-racist outlook to support the health and wellbeing of the children of color and transracial adoptees.

Transracial caregiving/adoption is a multifaceted journey for the entire family, but it is often the adoptee who bears the brunt of navigating the complexity of the experience. The nuanced perspectives of transracial adoptees are often overlooked in White-dominated spaces, including school communities, society at large.
